Swimming Lessons

As part of the PE curriculum pupils are required to have swimming lessons at school to enable them to learn how to swim in a safe environment. The National Curriculum states that:



All schools must provide swimming instruction either in key stage 1 or key stage 2.

In particular, pupils should be taught to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

Your child will participate in swimming lessons every Friday morning at Victory Swimming Pool, starting from 22nd March 2024 - 24th May 2024. Transportation to the swimming pool will be provided through the school bus.

To ensure your child's active participation, kindly ensure they bring a swimming costume/trunks, a swimming hat (either cotton or plastic), goggles (optional), and a towel. Please note: swimming hats are compulsory and can be purchased via school money for ± 1.06 .

If your child is unwell or unable to swim, please inform the office. Even if unable to participate directly, they will still attend the pool to observe and learn.
